
Post-Appointment Certification Process

The following steps will help to ensure your successful enrollment in the PA MMJ Program...

1. Visit the Registry on the PA MMJ Program website: www.medicalmarijuana.pa.gov
 - a. If you registered on the site prior to your appointment with Dr. Mincer, you will receive an email from the State in 1-2 days indicating that Dr. Mincer has processed your certification.
 - b. If you did not register on the site prior to your appointment, visit the site and register. Dr. Mincer cannot process your certification until you complete the initial registration. Email our office once you've completed the registration.

IN EITHER CASE, PLEASE ALLOW 1-3 DAYS FOR DR. MINCER TO PROCESS YOUR CERTIFICATION AND THE STATE TO EMAIL YOU. Then return to the site and pay the fee.

Some helpful registration hints we have learned along the way...

- The applicant must have PA identification that is not expired
 - Use a laptop or desktop, not an iPad
 - The information must be EXACTLY how it appears on your driver's license (Ex: "Street" vs "St" or "Lane" vs "Ln")
 - All information must be in capital letters
 - Follow date of birth formatting that is required
 - Use Internet Explorer, Chrome, or Firefox (not Safari)
 - If your name is hyphenated, leave out the hyphen and put a space in place
 - If your name includes a full middle name, skip it because the box only allows for middle initial
 - Follow exact instructions for creating a password
 - If you cannot register, contact the helpline listed on the site
2. Your PA MMJ ID Card will arrive in the mail 7-10 days after you pay your fee.
 3. While waiting for your ID card to arrive, call the dispensary of your choice and make an appointment for an initial consultation. Many dispensaries require this for a first-time visit.
 - a. See separate handout for a list of SE Pennsylvania dispensaries.
 - b. Appointment availability, product pricing and product availability vary, so you may want to call a few dispensaries.
 - c. You must take your MMJ ID Card to the dispensary appointment, so schedule accordingly.
 - d. You do not need a paper prescription to visit the dispensary. Your recommended product and dosing will be sent electronically to ALL dispensaries by Dr. Mincer. That being said, it's still a good idea to bring the Summary print out that was given to you to your visit to the dispensary.
 4. Begin using your recommended product according to the regimen Dr. Mincer has advised.
 - a. You can have direct access to Dr. Mincer via our Patient Portal for any clinical questions or concerns. Please check your email for instructions from Patient Fusion on how to set up an account.
